## COURSE OVERVIEW

The TNCC Provider Course is designed to provide core-level trauma knowledge and psychomotor skills associated with the delivery of professional nursing care to the trauma patient. The content is presented through lectures and 6 psychomotor skill stations.



## TARGET AUDIENCE

Any RN interested in improving their trauma nursing skills. It is recommended that participants have 6-12 months experience in the emergency setting. (LPNs and paramedics may audit the course.)

## COURSE PREPARATION

TNCC is a course where your knowledge and skills will be evaluated. Because this is a course where your knowledge and skills are tested, it is recommended that you read the entire manual at least once prior to attending the course. You should receive your manual 30 days prior to the course.

## WHAT DO I GET WHEN I COMPLETE THE TRAUMA NURSING CORE COURSE?

RN's successful in all testing will be issued a TNCC provider verification card and receive 18 CECH from ENA for attending the entire course. All other participants may attend the lectures and practice the psychomotor skill stations, and will be issued 13.2 CECH from ENA for attending the course. Only RN's are eligible for testing the psychomotor skill stations and taking the written exam.

**Refund Policy** \$100.00 will be refunded only if cancellation is received in writing 20 days prior to the course.

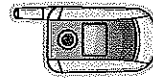
