### Course Description

The Trauma Nursing Core Course (TNCC) is a nationally standardized basic trauma nursing course developed by the Emergency Nurses Association. It is designed to establish a consistent knowledge base for nurses involved in the care of the trauma patient.

### Target Audience

It is recommended that RN participants have at least six to twelve months of clinical emergency nursing experience prior to attending the course. Non-RN healthcare providers may audit a course, but will not receive a verification card.

### Certification

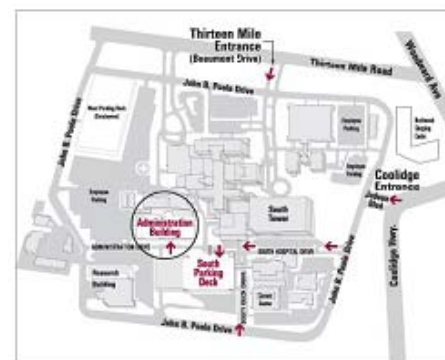
Upon successful completion of the TNCC course, all RN participants will receive 14.42 contact hours. Participants MUST attend the

entire course in order to receive the contact hours. You must be successful in all testing in order to receive an TNCC provider card from the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA).

The Emergency Nurses Association is accredited as a provider of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.
